Have you heard about the GDPR?

The GDPR is the European Union (EU's) General Data Protection Regulations which come into force on May 25, 2018. This is a set of laws regulating the processing of personal data in the EU. There are some aspects to the GDPR that are of importance to companies whether or not they do business directly with the EU.

Companies will be subject to the law if they:

- Have a physical presence in the EU
- Offer goods and services to EU residents
- Are a third party processor of personal data of EU residents
- Collect data on behaviours of individuals in the EU

The GDPR defines consent and outlines the conditions under which consent must be obtained. There is no exception for B2B communications or information. Data breach notification is mandatory within 72 hours of a breach being noted. The GDPR has the highest fines in the world for those deemed to be in breach of the regulations. Penalties can be assessed on global income.

Those with rights under these regulations have both a "right to access" and a "right to be forgotten". They are entitled to know what personal data an organization has on them and receive such information without a fee. They may also require that an organization remove their personal data from their systems.

It is important that your organization determine whether the GDPR applies to your business activities. If it does apply, you will need to make sure you are in compliance with the regulations. The following websites are good starting points for further information:

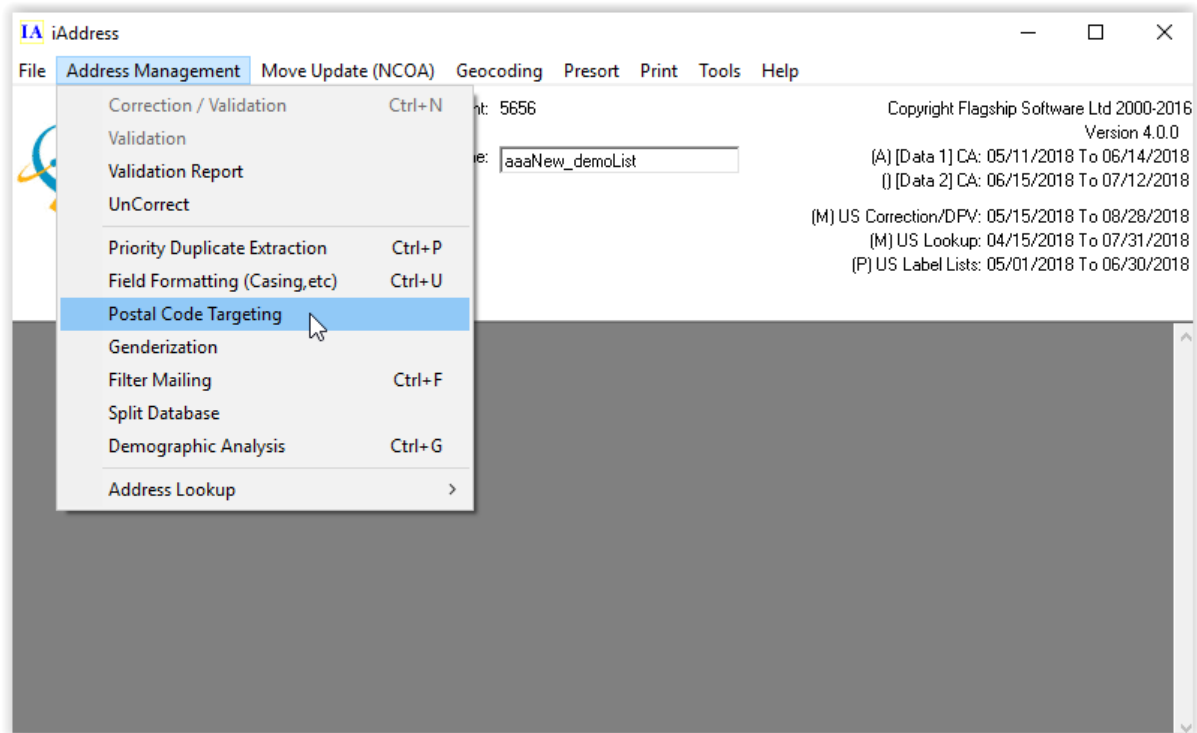
